SA tawny port casks have had a huge impact this unpretentious beast of a whisky. Don't expect too much complexity, just a whack of cocoa, salted caramel, toasted oak and vanilla. All coming in at a wonderful 52.9%. Yum!

COLLECTIVUM XXVIII 35.0
Scotland

A wonderful blend of all of Diageo's 28 single malt distilleries, from Campbeltown to Speyside, Highlands to Islay, they're all in there. Shortbread and sponge cake, orange, faint peat and sweet, fruity malt. A limited release from 2017, there won't be many of these laying around anymore.

LAGAVULIN 12YR 18.0
Islay, Scotland

My favourite 'standard' bottling of Lagavulin, the 12 year. All of the traditional earthy, peaty notes you would expect from the 16 year but slightly brighter with it's youth. Not to mention coming in at cask strength. You'll find the 8 and 16 years in most good bars, give this 12 year a go.

HAKUSHU 12YR 32.0
Yamanashi, Japan

Japan have become renowned for the incredible whiskies they produce and Suntory are at the top of the game. I feel as if Hibiki and Yamazaki dominate the market and overshadow Hakushu sometimes, but it's my favourite of the trio. Japanese distilleries are struggling with demand and age statements are becoming more expensive and harder to find. Do yourself a favour and grab one while you can. Clean and crisp, extremely complex yet very delicate. Hakushu is lightly peated.
